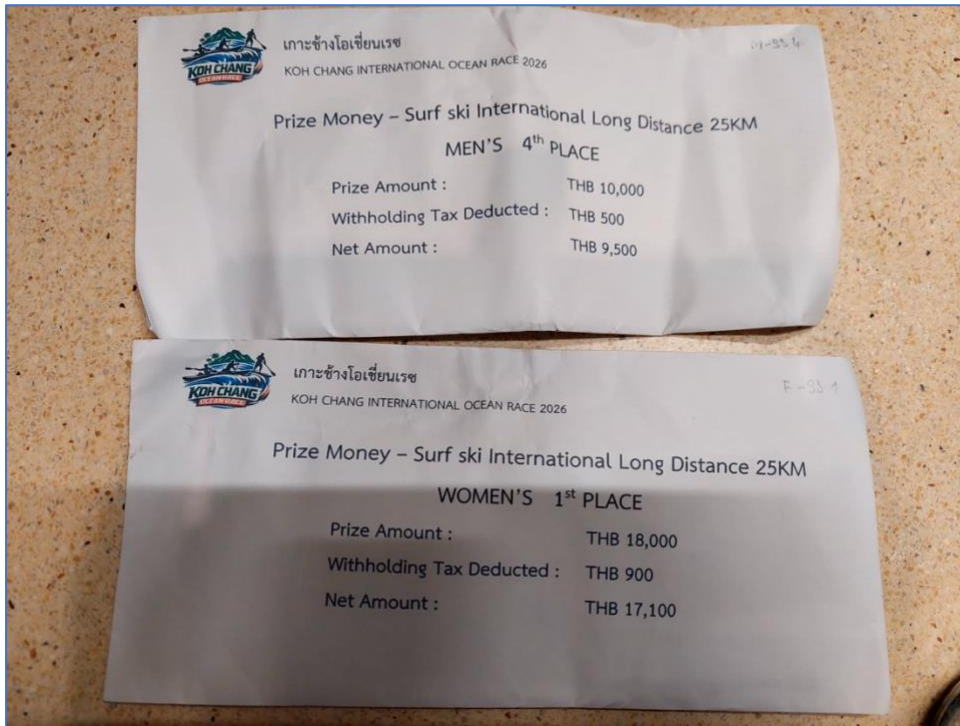
Congratulations!

SPECIAL MENTION

I'd also like to take the opportunity to give a special mention to our local outrigger community. This month saw the return of the iconic Hamilton Island Cup after a 10-year hiatus. Two of our local outrigger clubs, Cronulla and Port Hacking, sent crews to compete in what is widely regarded as one of Australia's most challenging ocean outrigger events.

In the 16 km OC6 race, two crews finished an impressive 16th and 18th out of a field of 46 boats. The longer 42 km changes race saw both a men's OC6 crew and a women's OC6 crew take on the demanding course, with both crews finishing third in their respective divisions. Unlike a standard distance race, a changes race adds another layer of complexity. Fresh paddlers wait chest-deep in the ocean for a well-choreographed manoeuvre, while the finishing crew leaps into the water and the new crew scrambles aboard—all within seconds. A fast, well-executed change can gain valuable time, while a poor exchange can cost a team several places. It's a spectacular display of teamwork, skill and trust under often challenging ocean conditions.

Conditions throughout the event were extremely challenging, with ocean swell, wind and currents, making these results even more impressive. While it may not be kayaking, it is very much part of our wider paddling community, and these outstanding performances are certainly worthy of a shout-out. Congratulations to everyone who represented our local clubs.
